Among the main differences with the previous Nauta 108, the fashion plates are visually integrated with the dark windows that run along the Main deck salon and a 6m tender with its crane are located on the main deck forward.

Her interiors are bright and airy, and the generous hull volume allows for spacious lodging for the Owners and their guests. Accommodation is split between the Main deck master and four spacious cabins below decks, but guests are likely to spend most of their time either in the cockpit, with its uninterrupted views aft, or on the sprawling Sun deck. 



